The revamped ATAC website is top priority for ATAC/W&M as this will be used to sell on W&M merchandise/Tour T-shirts.

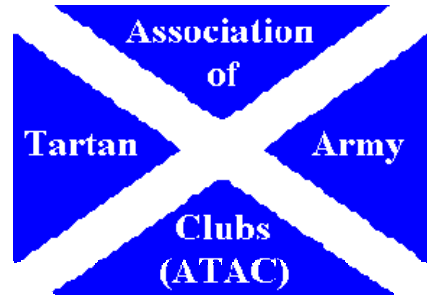
